 1. Since no reference plan from either individual that wanted to purchase a portion of the laneway between Lot 10 and Lot 35 on James Street has been received, the TMSA Planner has suggested that the Township have the survey completed ASAP and send each individual an invoice for his share in order to get the process moving forward. Therefore, a motion to hire SOS to survey the laneway is required in order to proceed.
 2. Alamos Gold Inc. has confirmed a \$3,479.26 donation to the Gym.
 3. Copy of a letter of support regarding Interfor's application for funding the installation of a KMW Biomass Fired Energy System at their Elk Lake facility.
 4. Records from 2015 to 2024 indicate that \$98,100 has been spent on Council Fees....that is less than \$10,000 per year. In most cases, annual fees for many committees have to be paid and the Township has no control over and in most instances obtained very little benefit from most of these groups.
