Please find above a summary of the proposed 2025 Budget for the Township of James. The budget 'as is' results in a 1.9% increase for residential property (\$28.95/year if there is no change in assessed value). Assessed values of properties are determined by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation. In addition, the Education Tax Rate is set by the Province.

In addition to the nominal increase in taxes, water users are advised that as of December 31/24, the Water Treatment Plant had a deficit of over \$65,385. (Please see Page 23 of the Auditor's Report.) As a result, Council has been advised by the Auditors to increase water usage rates each year until the deficit is depleted and a surplus is established. The water system must be self-sustaining in the future. Therefore, there will be a 10% increase to water users for the remaining 6-months of 2025 and a further 5% increase/year until the water system reserve is established.

As in past years, rate payers are welcome to review the detailed 2025 Budget at the Municipal Office during week days from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily.

Draft By-Law #25-07 is scheduled to be adopted by Council at the August 13th/25 Regular Meeting.

#### **BY-LAW 25-07**

#### BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT 2025 TAX RATES AND TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTY AND INTEREST IN DEFAULT OF PAYMENT THEREOF.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that the Council of a municipality shall, after the adoption of estimates for the year, pass a by-law to levy a separate tax rate on the assessment in each property class; and,

WHEREAS the said Act requires tax rates to be established in the same proportion to tax ratios; and whereas Council has set tax ratios by By-Law #25-07; and,

WHEREAS the 2025 levy for municipal purposes is \$888,903; and,

WHEREAS certain education rates are provided in various regulations, and have been requisitioned by the Province;

**NOW THEREFORE** Council of The Corporation of the Township of James enacts as follows:

1. That the tax rates for municipal and education purposes be hereby set as follows:

- 2. That the amounts required and collected by this by-law shall be reduced by the amounts levied and collected by the interim levy authorized by **By-Law No. 25-02** of The Corporation of the Township of James.
- 3. That all taxes shall become due and payable in two equal or approximately equal instalments on September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025 and November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- 4. The Tax Collector and the Treasurer of The Corporation of the Township of James shall mail or cause to be mailed to the address of the residence or place of business of each property or person a notice specifying the amount of taxes payable by such persons pursuant to the provisions of this by-law.
- 5. The taxes payable pursuant to this by-law shall be paid into the office of the Treasurer or Tax Collector for The Corporation of the Township of James on or before the respective due dates hereinbefore set forth.
