### Objection to Acceptance of Minutes of Council Meeting of March 12, 2025

We have no mechanism to address issues from previous council meeting presentations by Delegations. Presentations made, if no on-hand knowledge is present, are taken verbatim and decisions have been made based on that knowledge or lack thereof. We advocate transparency but how can practice this if we do not validate the points upon which our 'transparent' conclusions and decision are based.

Prior to blanket acceptance of minutes of previous meetings, presentations, if warranted, should be entertained at next council meeting that enlighten council and ensure transparent decisions are made on transparent facts or claims.

Presentations by delegations that claim certain facts or truths should be agreed upon, challenged or verified dependent on the knowledge of council members. This allows council to undergo potential legal scrutiny of any decision it has made and minimizes potential legal challenges.

# Challenges to Minutes of Feb. 12

McMahon claimed that it would not be cost effective to move the shed.

This is not true. Cost of purchasing the land upon which the shed sits, in order to not move it, is +\$7500. All costs included. Cost to move the shed 25 metres onto property McMahon already owns is \$2500 Councilor McIntyre stated that the shed must be removed and the laneway split 50/50 Lengthwise. Councilor Cormier agreed. With Councilor De Carlo having already agreed to that split in previous correspondence in November of 2024, and at this meeting, that giving the decision a 3-2 council split, this should have been a carried motion with no further discussion.

"McMahon further stated that Steve would accept a 7' x 120' split" - this is from a stated quote from the minutes. Either the minutes are incorrect or the memories of council members are incorrect. Things do not appear very transparent.

A "Carried" motion by Cormier/De Carlo states,

A motion to reject Henry Fiset and Sons Ltd. Offer to purchase the Township's gravel pit.

In Councilor De Carlo's previous submission to council on possible sale of assets that are not part of the Townships core business and in competition with other businesses in town, the sale of the gravel pit by Councilor De Carlo was advocated. This was in all Council Packages.

The motion may have been written in haste with all communication not fully understood, as in the misstated McMahon quote above. Councilor De Carlo was not in agreement with the proposed terms of the offer by Fiset, but in agreement with the idea in principal. As Councilor Fiset had declared a conflict on this issue and Councilor McIntyre was not physically present at the meeting, the only 2 who could have signed were Cormier/De Carlo who, with lack of proper description of the motion or in haste, initialed the motion as currently worded.
